DELTA AIRLINES EXPANDS SERVICE AT GAINESVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT

Two Additional Daily Flights to Increase Number of Available Weekly Seats by 1400

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – Jan. 29, 2009 – Gainesville Regional Airport (GNV) is pleased to announce that Delta Air Lines has initiated two more daily, roundtrip flights between GNV and Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL), increasing the total number of daily flights to eight.

The flights are operated by Atlanta Southeast Airlines (ASA), utilizing a 50-seat regional jet. This increase in capacity will add approximately 1400 additional weekly seats in our market. The flights will be operated as follows beginning March 2, with certain day-of-week adjustments:

In Gainesville, Delta and US Airways have been operating flights with strong load factors (percentage of seats filled on the aircraft), with Delta operating at 77 percent full in December and US Airways at 74 percent. The total number of passengers increased by more than 7 percent in the same month compared to December 2007. “Delta officials expressed that Gainesville is a strong market, which resulted in their decision to increase capacity,” said Allan Penksa, airport CEO. “Many cities have seen a decline in air service; we are fortunate to enjoy improved service during times of economic uncertainty and ask that the community support the service in order to continue the improvements.”
