GAINESVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT TO RECOGNIZE FIVE-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF THE SEPTEMBER 11 TRAGEDY

GAINESVILLE, Fla – Sept. 8, 2006 – Gainesville Regional Airport will recognize the five-year anniversary of the September 11 terrorist attacks by taking a moment of silence on Monday, Sept. 11.

At 8:40 a.m., Deputy Federal Security Director Frank Stagl will announce the moment of silence that will take place at 8:46 a.m. over the PA system. Seconds prior to 8:46 a.m., he will ask Airport employees and tenant employees to join him in remembrance of the September 11, 2001 tragedy. Passenger check-in and screening will stop for 1 minute.

“This moment gives everyone the opportunity to remember the lives that were taken and the families and friends that suffered, as well as the heroic efforts that took place on September 11. It is certainly a day that will never be forgotten,” Stagl said.
