US AIRWAYS EXPRESS ADDS A FIFTH JET IN THE SCHEDULE FOR NOVEMBER

GAINESVILLE, Fla – Sept. 17, 2007 – US Airways announced that they added a 50-seat CRJ-200 aircraft to the schedule for the month of November.

“If the flights are successful in November, it is quite possible that they will look at other occasions where they can add a flight or possibly a flight on a permanent basis,” said Allan Penksa, Airport CEO. “This addition shows US Airways’ desire to compete in this market. I think we will see further announcements in the future.”

With this addition in the schedule, US Airways will have five daily jets departing to Charlotte. The flights are in the schedule from November 4 until November 26. Flight 2537 will depart Charlotte at 8:59 p.m. and arrive in Gainesville at 10:22 p.m. on November 4, which will operate every day except Saturday. Flight 2542 will depart Gainesville at 9 a.m. for an arrival in Charlotte at 10:18 a.m. on November 5 and will operate every day except Sunday. This will be an additional 2200 seats in the schedule for the month of November.
