DELTA ADDS A SEVENTH DAILY FLIGHT, US AIRWAYS ADDS 70-SEAT JETS

GAINESVILLE, Fla – Oct. 29, 2008 – Delta announced the addition of a seventh 50-seat CRJ-200 aircraft for the months of November and December and US Airways has added a 70-seat jet in the November weekend schedule.

Both airlines have been operating all jets with high load factors (percentage of seats filled on the aircraft). These upcoming air service improvements will provide an additional 2500 seats for the month of November and an additional 1500 seats in December. With Gainesville’s improvement in on-time performance and increase in flights and seats, passengers will experience a greater level of air service.

“While capacity has significantly declined this fall at many airports nationwide, our airport will see air service improvements in November and December,” said Allan Penksa, Airport CEO. “Our airlines recognize that the demand for air service in our market continues to be strong and the fall is a busier time of the year for North Central Florida.”

With this addition in the schedule, Delta will have seven daily flights to Atlanta, connecting passengers to destinations worldwide in November and seven flights in December, Monday through Wednesday.

US Airways will operate its 70-seat CRJ-200 in addition to its three 50-seat jets every Sunday in November.
