

**AMERICAN EAGLE ANNOUNCES WINTER SCHEDULE,
OFFERING INCREASED SERVICE AND CONVENIENCE AT ITS MIAMI HUB**

American Eagle will increase nonstop service between Miami and 10 additional cities throughout the American Airlines network, beginning Nov. 18.

The airline will also introduce two new daily nonstop flights from Miami to Cleveland on Nov. 18. This is in addition to previously announced service between Miami and Gainesville, Fla., that begins Oct. 1. American Eagle will expand to more than 300 daily departures from Miami, solidifying the hub as the premier gateway to the Americas.
